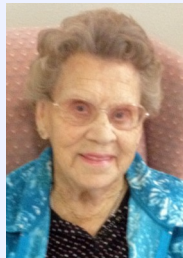

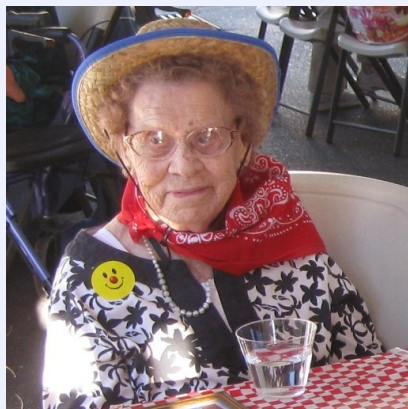
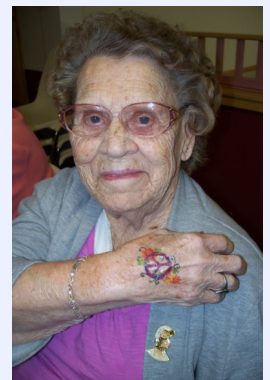
Lucille Walden Turns 100 on July 7



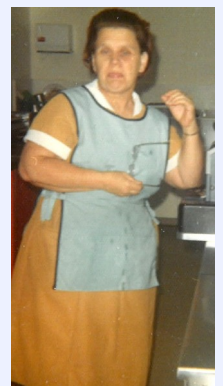
Lucille lives life to its fullest. She always gets things done with determination and drive. She is the head of a large and loving family, a mother of eight children and several grandchildren.

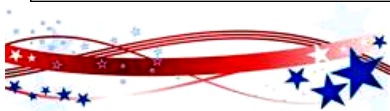
